Introduction

Education is a derived word in English from a Latin word 'e ducare' which means 'dig out'; Digging out good values from human minds for the well being of the universal manhood. Human creatures have more senses than other creatures i.e., fauna and flora such human creatures, by using his senses, controls and rules all other creatures. It helped, initially for a harmonious living on this earth. But scientific advancement made individuals to think about them. There arose selfishness. This selfishness concentrates self advancements. What is Value Education?

Policies of NCERT

NCERT – National Council for Education and Training has stressed the need for imparting students the moral and spiritual values in one of its National Conference on Minimum Curriculum standards in July, 1970. The NCERT, again in its National Seminar on Primary and Work oriented Education in November 1976, to commemorate **International Education Year** analyses the relevance of the Gandhian values in reforming education. And it has recommended that Gandhian values can be included at the primary stage to inculcate values in the minds of the students. The Gandhian values are:

- 1. Dignity of manual labor
- 2. Sense of social awareness and responsibility
- 3. Equal consideration for all religious
- 4. Being faithful and fearless
- 5. Non-violence and service to the society
- 6. Contributing to global peace

These values will build a peaceful human community if they are imparted through education.

Recommendations of the National Policy on Education

The National Policy on Education which was drafted in 1986 made recommendations on the need for value education in India. It reads as follows:

- Scientific and Technological advancement has entirely changed the life style of the people and this advancements is used every day to manufacture mass destructing weapons;
- 2. It poses a heavy threat to the human existence now.
- 3. It eroded traditional values and leads the students to face many immoral situations.
- 4. They will have to decide everything on their own without the assistance of the elders.
- 5. The present youth questions the elders without having any relevance of traditional values.

These are the consequences when future Indian - the present youth does not practice values in their life. The traditional connect will be lost and hence peace and harmony will be lost. If so, where will human being live? So, it is the need of the hour to have value education in our educational system. This value education should be included as an integral part of our education which we can never separate from the educational process.

Gandhiji on Educational Policy

Gandhiji says, 'education is an all-round development, drawing out of the best in the child. Literacy, according to Gandhi, is not the beginning, and it is not the end of education but it is a mean whereby man and woman can be educated. Gandhiji proposes three domains; they are,

- 1. Hand-psychomotor domain
- 2. Heart-spiritual domain
- 3. Head-cognitive domain

When Bloom discusses about psycho-motor domain, it is the behavior of performing actions that are neuromuscular in nature and demand certain levels of physical activity. And he further says this psychomotor includes imitation, manipulation, precision, articulation and naturalization in its activities.

Heart and Spiritual Domain

This domain includes understanding the divine nature in creation, the relation between nature and man and the connectivity among the men. It ultimately leads to nurturing values. It makes man emotional.

Head Cognitive Domain

Wikipedia says that cognitive science is an inter- disciplinary, scientific study of the mind and its process. It examines the nature of the tasks and the functions of cognition. This branch of study analyses how intelligence and behavior are useful in transforming information through nervous system. It is a typical field according to Wikipedia, which includes language, perception, memory, attention, reasoning and emotion as its mental features and barrows concepts from the fields of linguistics, psychology, artificial intelligence, philosophy, neuro-science and anthropology to understand the mental faculties. The Wikipedia further says under the title cognitive science that the fundamental cognitive science is that thinking can best be understood in terms of representational structures in the mind and computational procedures that operate on those structures. Head cognitive domain is the science of mind and such mental study should be incorporated, in our educational system to develop a positive outcome in the young minds.

Principles of 3r's

The three r's proposed by Gandhi are Read, Write and Arithmetic. These are skill oriented education. These are the basic skills which every individual should acquire through education. The primary motif of primary education is imparting these 3 r's. A man, in this modern society cannot live without these 3 r's. Reading is leading an individual to diverse field, writing makes everyone right and rightful and arithmetic is the basic computing skill which is essential for an individual to lead the life, with meaningful economics. All these three r's are the eyes of human life. The primary education at first, should aim at these three r's to make life meaningful.

Implementation of Basic Education

Gandhiji advocates for three things in implementing the basic education in educational institutions. They are:

- 1. Primary education should be compulsory and free. There should be no change for elementary education so that everyone in India will be enabled to avail education.
- 2. Education should be imparted through mother tongue. Mother tongue will give students a free thinking and embolden them to express their thoughts. A strange language will scare the learners. Education is knowledge and to acquire knowledge, why a strange language should be the medium of institution? It is a double luggage on the back of the students; Acquiring knowledge is one task and before acquiring it, the students should learn a strange language which is totally unnecessary and unwanted. If any individual needs any language other than his / her mother tongue, they can learn it on their own cost for their self interest. Mother tongue, according to Gandhi should be the medium of instruction in all educational institutions.

Craft Education

Gandhi strongly pleads for craft education. If an individual learns a craft like knitting, weaving, agriculture, he will become self-reliant. The purpose of education is to make everyone self reliant. Learning a craft makes everyone self-confident and self-reliant. If knitting or weaving may not now be appropriate, then we can go for some basic skills in Computer Science. As time changes, the type of craft may also be changed.

Learning a craft is an optional subject in schools now. If we are to implement Gandhiji's principles in our educational system, craft education should be made compulsory. Gandhiji's vision in education is an all-round development of an individual. The imparting education should stimulate the spiritual thirst, intellectual quest and physical burst of children. Education will be made holistic when you apply Gandhiji's principles which aim at values. These values bring value to everyone and education should be the best entity which should bring up values among the students.

To enrich Education

Education enriches everyone. But we should enrich education with the current needs of the society. Though man lives as a citizen of a global village, he is living in his mother land. He has his own commitment to his nation and this nation has also got its commitment to her citizen. So, such mutual commitment should be accomplished through education. Our India needs a citizen one who is healthy, patriotic and moralistic. Our mother India urgently needs a healthy, patriotic and moralistic society. We, Indians, do not have health consciousness. We do not know now what to eat and how to eat. Our young generation does not want to know the cause and effect of our food culture; they are not aware what food code our forefathers followed and how they lived healthily. Even the snacks they ate had medicinal values and helped a disease free life. We, the young generation, now leads a new style of living and also witness new life style diseases, like diabetics, heart diseases, kidney failures and diseases etc. These are not inborn diseases but by the life we lead following European culture. Our Governments should educate our citizens that we have our own golden culture and it should be practiced. This can be achieved through our education only. Our society should be taught of our culture and heritage to cater to the needs of our country. Our education should have a double fold aim, one is to fulfill the personal needs and another is to cater to the global needs. Every individual in India should be both as a citizen of India and at the same time a member of this global community.

Knowledge to be Included in the Syllabus

Every student irrespective of course whether he is an Undergraduate or a Postgraduate, or arts or science, or professional or managements studies, he or she should be taught compulsorily three essential papers. They are as follows:

- 1. Moral literature in their mother tongue.
- 2. Basic military training and history of our country.
- 3. Basic General Law clubbed with Healthy education.

These three subjects should be made mandatory to make every Indian healthy both mentally and physically, patriotic and self reliable. Moral literature in mother tongue will make the students mentally strong and mother tongue loving. When students occupy higher administrative positions, the moral literature which they learnt in their courses will guide them not to indulge in bribing activities. Basic general law will teach them to live with confidence that they can never be exploited and health education will prevent them from acquiring life style diseases. All Indians will be choosy of harmless food, avoiding fried food culture. Health education will make them hygienic and will provide a preventive mechanism.
